## Kenton City Schools' Hardin County Fair Guidelines

With the Kenton City Schools District being in session during the Hardin County Fair, we have been asked to clarify attendance rules concerning excused absences, perfect attendance and assignment makeup procedures. The administrative guideline covers those concerns and relates only to the Hardin County Fair, not surrounding county fairs or other activities.

- A. The following activities will be considered a "field trip" activity and, as such, the student will be excused and the absence will not affect perfect attendance:
  - Being a member of the Junior Fair Board (excused all week).
  - Showing a livestock project.
  - Performing/Working as part of a school group.
  - Non-livestock projects during judging.
  - Taking care of livestock project.

## \*\*\*\*\*If this pertains to your student please fill out <u>Form A</u> on the back of this sheet.

- B. The following activities will be considered excused absences but will count against perfect attendance:
  - Watching a family member show project.

- Students excused with written permission of parent/guardian. \*\*\*\*\*If this pertains to your student please fill out <u>Form B</u> on the back of this sheet.

- C. The following activities will be considered as <u>unexcused</u> absences:
  - Working at games, rides, food concessions, etc.

For "field trip" absences or excused absences, students will be given one day makeup time for each day absent. Makeup days begin on the Monday following the fair.

Example: If a student missed one day for the Hardin County Fair, they would have the Monday after the fair to makeup work and it would be due during the regular class time on Tuesday.

Work, tests, projects, etc. missed due to <u>unexcused</u> absences will not receive credit. Assignments will be given to students prior to the absence if they are available and can be accomplished in that manner.

Example: A science lab that needs to be done in the science room and needs proper supervision cannot be sent home.

All written excuses must be presented to the student's school of attendance prior to the absence to be considered for "field trip" or excused status.
