1. Review and Finalize Scope of Work Year 2 Assurance Area D Evaluation Systems Coordinator asked all members of the team to review this document in Google Docs. The following revisions were made by the team:

Added #3 Target to read: Develop comprehensive models for teacher and principal evaluations, including timelines, activities, and personnel, with the goal of full implementation of new evaluation system by 2013-2014.

Added #3 Activity to read: If selected, Kenton City Schools will participate in the OTES pilot.

2. March Progress Monitoring Document Discussion and Updates.

Coordinator distributed a document entitled, "Kenton City School District Survey Project-March 13, 2012" explaining the contract with KCS and Muskingum Valley ESC. The Open Ended Items page was reviewed. Questions revised for the survey:

Staff: Has the professional development offered by our district in the past two years been supportive for improving student learning?

Revision: Do you feel the PD you have participated in during the past two years has been or will be supportive for student learning- (all PD you are provided including 2 hour delays)

Parent: Are you satisfied with the way the Kenton City Schools have worked to improve students' learning and overall communication?

Revision: Are you satisfied with the way KCS have worked to improve students' learning? Are you satisfied with the way KCS has worked to improve overall communication?

3. Can PD in April and May support our not yet completed Year 2 Goals? 2. By May 2012, 100% of CORE area teaching staff will participate in professional development sessions regarding formative instructional practices, which include formative and performance-based assessments.
